

# Paperboard packaging



## Yes please

- Paperboard and cardboard boxes
- Corrugated cardboard on a roll
- Paper tubes
- Toilet paper and paper towel tubes

## No thanks

- Packages that have come into direct contact with chemotherapy drugs or antibiotics
- Packages containing food remnants
- Large cardboard boxes that don't fit in the waste vacuum system

## Handling

Remove plastic pockets and other foreign material that is easily removed. Put in the 60 L paper bag intended for paperboard packaging (see list of bags). Close the bag securely by rolling the mouth shut, put in the waste vacuum system and select Paperboard packaging. Please only put in one bag at a time.

Large cardboard boxes that are too big to put in the waste vacuum system can be placed on top of the AGV trolley in the recycling room.
